Leadership and Community Service

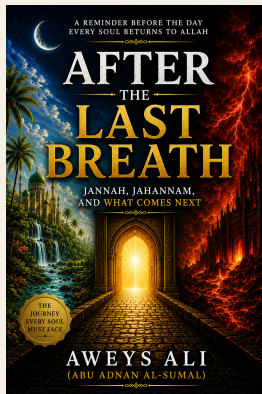
2016	Elected Vice President of the Somali Bantu Association of Louisville, supporting community coordination and family needs.

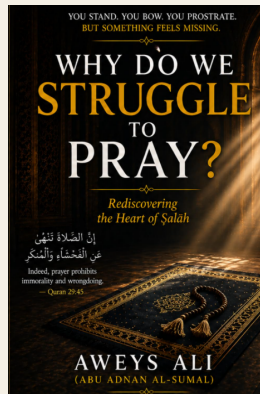

Books and Publishing

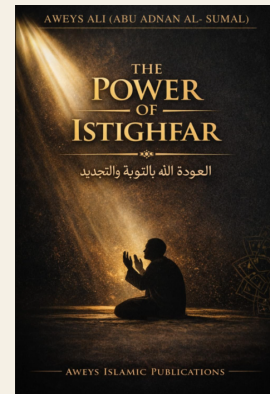

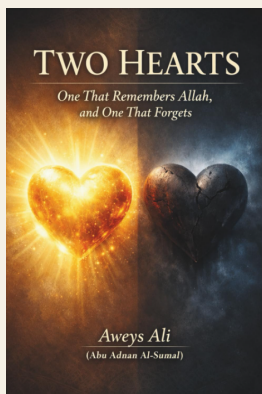

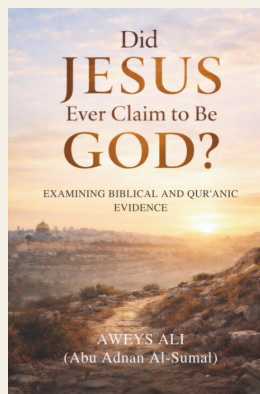
